Our School is Co - educational School, runs from April to March and admissions are normally completed from January to March for all classes. For entry into Nursery, the child must have attained the age of 3+ years by 31st March of that year. The admission to Classes KG I to XII will be considered on the availability of seats.

During admission, a parent must submit the Registration form provided from the school, with a copy of the child's previous year's report card, a copy of birth certificate, two passport size photographs duly fixed on the form. If a child is offered an admission a parent must complete the admission procedure in the school premises itself.
